### **About the Nannine Clay Wallis House and Arboretum**

Mrs. Wallis was the second president of The Garden Club of Kentucky. The House is on the National Register of Historical Places. The Arboretum is "the largest old tree collection in Central Kentucky," containing fine examples of old and new introductions of trees, shrubs, and flowers.
